LSD stones

Rules

The Prague Circles 2025 will be played in 3 groups of 4 teams.

Maximum of 8 ends may be played. The time limit is 1 hour and 50 minutes for the game

When the clock runs to 00:00 teams will complete the end being played and no other end is being played.

There is a 5 minute break after the 4th end that is already part of the time limit.

Unless stated otherwise WCF rules will apply. The no tick rule will apply for this tournament.

The team listed on the top of the scoreboard will play the red stones.

There will be a 5 minutes practise before every game.

At the conclusion of each team's pregame practice, two stones will be delivered to the tee at the home end, by different players

– the first stone with a clockwise and the second with a counter clockwise rotation.

The number of LSD stones for each player will not be controlled.

Please wait for the official to measure your LSD stone. Together it will be 8 LSD stones during the tournament.

The single least favourable result is automatically eliminated when calculating the average distance.

Before the tournament, each team can have a 60-mins practise during the Friday morning.

Please write the OC till 17th of March.

After the games in the group the overall ranking is being made by points and average of LSD stones. Teams are divided again to three groups (1st-5th, 6th-10th, 11th-15th place).

No teams are allowed to play with each other more than once except the final round.

There will be one time out per team. One person of the opposing team is also able to come to speak with the other team.

In case of time out, two more minutes (1-min travel time + 1-min time out) will be added to the game time limit.

So the maximum of 4 minutes can be added if both teams use the time out during the game.

The organizers reserve the right to make changes in the system of play if required and to make ruling decisions.

Games in groups

The winner of the game earns 3 points, the opposite team 0 points.

If a 'Games in groups' game is tied at the conclusion of the last end then each team will play 1 stone towards the Home End to decide the winner.

Team without the hammer starts.

The team with a stone closer to the center of the House wins the game and earns 2 points.

The team with the stone further from the center of the house earns 1 point.

If it ends with the same value of the LSD stones and the stones are in the house (dist.<185,4 cm), both teams get 2 points.

If it ends with the same value of the LSD stones and the stones are NOT in the house (dist.=185,4 cm), both teams get 1 point.

The overall ranking is made after each team has played two games in the group.

The Final Round

The overall ranking is made again after each team has played two games in the new group.

TOP8 teams advance to the final round.

The 8-end games are played without a time limit.

There will be a 5-minute practice, but no LSD is thrown.

There is no extra time-out in extraend(s).

If a game is tied after the last end, the extraends are played until the winner of the game is decided.

The higher ranked team has choice of either the first or second practice or the stone handle colour.

The higher ranked team has the choice of delivering the last stone in the first end.

The organizers reserve the right to make changes in the system of play if required and to make ruling decisions.

The games 1 vs 2 game is closed. Other games of the final round are open.
